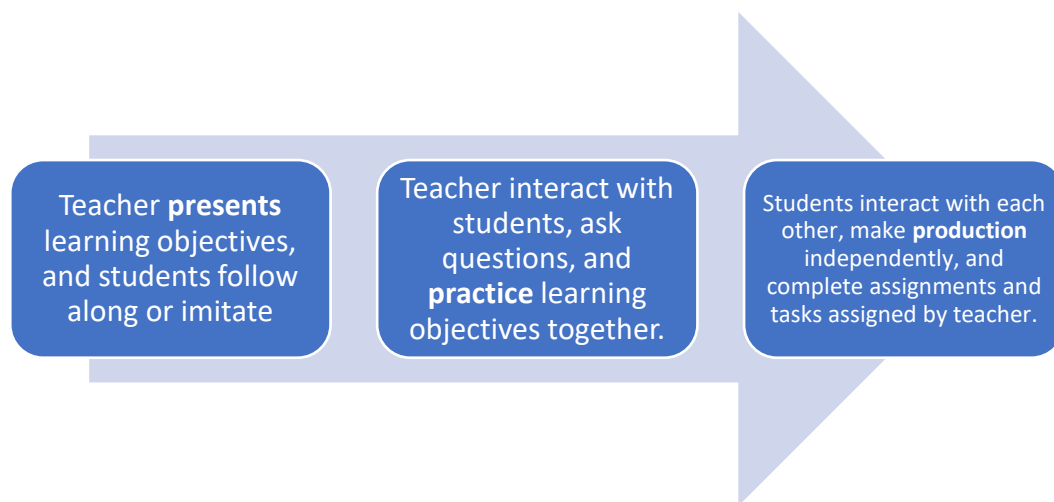


Mandarin Course (I)

 - c. Encourage students to speak, with survival Mandarin Chinese as the main teaching goal.




















































